- When:** **Sunday, November 16, 2008, 5:30 p.m.** (*Rain date Sunday, November 23, 5:30 p.m.*)
- Where:** National Memorial Arch, Valley Forge National Historical Park
- Why:** Valley Forge National Historical Park's historic character faces an imminent threat — an ill-advised development proposal on private land in the park. **The American Revolution Center proposes building a commercialized museum complex, including a hotel and conference center, on land that was critical to the Continental Army's 1777-78 encampment.** Valley Forge is a national icon that must be protected for our children and grandchildren to enjoy.

Come join General George Washington for a candlelight rally to show your support for Valley Forge's future. Following the event, there will be apple cider, snacks, and a chance to meet fellow park supporters.
